SHEEL NAGU, CHIEF JUSTICE (Oral)

It is not disputed at the Bar by learned Counsel for the rival parties that against the freezing order dated 07.03.2025 (Annexure P-2) passed by the Adjudicating Authority under Section 68F(2) of the Narcotic Drugs and Psychotropic Substances Act, 1985 (for short NDPS Act), an appeal has been preferred by Prem Singh-accused (son of the petitioner), before the Appellate Authority, vide Diary No. 1340 of 2025, which is pending adjudication.

Learned counsel for the State of Punjab assures that they would be following the due process of law as contained in Chapter VA of the NDPS Act before taking any coercive steps as regards the property in question.

In view of the assurance given by the learned counsel for the State of Punjab, this Court need not proceed with this matter and the same is disposed of, on the basis of aforesaid assurance.
