Prayer in the instant petition filed under Article 226 of the Constitution of India, is for issuance of directions to official respondents to provide protection of life and liberty to the petitioner at the hands of respondent No.4.

Learned counsel for the petitioner has submitted that he had moved a representation dated 07.07.2025 (Annexure P-1) before respondent No.2, but no action on the same has been taken till date and he would be satisfied, if respondent No.2 is directed to look into and decide the said representation.

Notice of motion.

Ms. Gagandeep Kaur, DAG, Punjab, accepts notice and submitted that she has no objection if the aforesaid representation dated 07.07.2025 (Annexure P-1) is looked into.

In view of the above, the present petition is *disposed of* with a direction to respondent No.2-the Commissioner of Police, Amritsar, to look into the aforesaid representation, and to take appropriate action as per law, if any required, at the earliest, regarding threat preception.
