1. The present petition has been filed under Section 528 of Bharatiya Nagarik Suraksha Sanhita, 2023 for quashing of FIR No.141 dated 07.08.2024, under Sections 420, 465, 467, 468, 471, 120-B IPC, registered at Police Station City Muktsar, District Sri Muktsar Sahib and all the subsequent proceedings arising therefrom on the basis of compromise (Annexure P-2).
2. Learned counsel for the petitioners submits that the FIR is outcome of a misunderstanding and with the intervention of the respectable of the society, the matter has now been compromised. He has referred to the compromise (Annexure P-2) in this regard.
3. Issue notice to the respondents.
4. On the asking of the Court, Mr. Kamalpreet Bawa, DAG, Punjab, accepts notice on behalf of respondent No.1. Learned State counsel states that no other FIR has been registered against the petitioners and they have no known criminal antecedents.



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5. At this stage, Ms. Kashakdeep Kaur, Advocate with Ms. Kirandeep Kaur, Advocate has entered appearance on behalf of respondent No.2 and filed her vakalatnama which is taken on record. She confirms the factum of the compromise having been effected between the parties and states that respondent No.2 has no objection to the quashing of the FIR in question.

6. I have heard learned counsel for the parties and have carefully gone through the material available on record.

7. In that view of the matter, even if this case is taken to its logical conclusion, it would only be an exercise in futility as the parties have already settled their differences. Therefore, no purpose would be served in wasting the time and resources of the State in pursuing this case to its pre-ordained end. It would, therefore, be better to give a quietus to the issue at this stage.

8. Accordingly, the petition is allowed and FIR No.141 dated 07.08.2024, under Sections 420, 465, 467, 468, 471, 120-B IPC, registered at Police Station City Muktsar, District Sri Muktsar Sahib and all other consequential proceedings arising therefrom qua the petitioners shall stand quashed qua the petitioners, however, subject to payment of Rs.5000/- as costs to be paid to the High Court Legal Services Committee.

9. Pending application(s), if any, shall also stand disposed of.
