HARSIMRAN SINGH SETHI J. (ORAL)

1. Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the petitioner has approached the Punjab School Education Board for the correction of his date of birth in the matriculation certificate where the same has been depicted as 11.02.1997 instead of 11.02.1998 but the respondents are not taking any action on the representation of the petitioner dated 11.11.2024 (Annexure P-5), which representation is still pending consideration with the respondents and the petitioner will be satisfied at this stage in case a time bound direction is issued to the respondents to decide the representation dated 11.11.2024 (Annexure P-5) by passing an appropriate speaking order.

2. Notice of motion.

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3. Ms. Mona Yadav, Advocate appears for Mr. Ranjit Singh Kalra, Advocate, who is present in the Court, accepts notice on behalf of respondent-PSEB.

4. Learned counsel for the respondent-PSEB submits that in case the representation dated 11.11.2024 (Annexure P-5) for correction of the date of birth has been received in the office of the concerned authorities and the same is still pending consideration with the authorities concerned, the same will be decided by the competent authority within a period of eight weeks from the date of the receipt of certified copy of this order by passing an appropriate speaking order. Learned counsel for the respondent-PSEB further submits that in case, after the decision any relief is to be extended to the petitioner, the same will be extended, otherwise due reasons will be mentioned in the speaking order to be passed for not accepting the claim of the petitioner which reasons will be conveyed to the petitioner for his information and necessary action.

5. Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that keeping in view the statement of learned counsel for the respondent-PSEB, the present writ petition may kindly be disposed of having been not pressed any further.
