1. The instant petition has been filed for initiation of contempt proceedings against the respondents for willfully disobeying the order dated 13.08.2024 (Annexure P-1), passed by the Writ Court in CWP-1025-2023, whereby, the following directions were passed:-

“6. In wake of the aforesaid, the present petition is disposed of with a direction to the respondents to pay interest at the rate of 6% per annum on the retiral benefits from the date they fell due till their realization, within a period of two months.”

2. Learned State counsel, on instructions from the General Manager, Haryana Roadways, Faridabad-respondent No.3, submits that the respondents undertake to comply with the aforesaid order within a period of 2 months qua the petitioner, as per law

3. In view of the aforesaid undertaking on behalf of the respondents, present petition is disposed of.



4. It is made clear that if the order dated 13.08.2024 is not complied with by the respondents within 02 months from today, the petitioner shall be entitled for revival of the petition.

5. Pending miscellaneous applications, if any, shall stand disposed of.
