On the basis of statement of complainant-Yashpal dated 17.10.2024, FIR No.399 dated 17.10.2024, under Section 127(6) of BNS, Police Station Sadar Nuh was registered.

In the status report that had been brought on record on 06.08.2025, it has been alleged that during investigation on 26.07.2025, the victim was produced by her family members. Her statement was recorded, wherein she stated that her husband Yahspal took her to Aligarh on the pretext of a trip. Then he sold him to a boy named Saurabh in Aligarh. Firstly he said that he would keep her with him and then he put a mangalsutra around her neck and married her. Saurabh did wrong things to her. He used to beat and forced himself on her. He did not even send her home. Her parents brought her at 4 o'clock last night, she tried to run away from Saurabh's house but was caught. Saurabh committed rape upon her due to which she was pregnant. When she used to live on rent in Aligarh, when

Saurabh kicked her in stomach then she was saved by the landlord there. Thereafter, offence under Section 115(2), 64(2), 143(2) of BNS have been added in case vide DD No.29 dated 26.07.2025. Physical examination of victim Poonam regarding the rape was got conducted by one Dr. Sahiba of CHC Nuh. During investigation on 01.08.2025 accused Saurabh was arrested and general physical examination and sexual test of aforesaid accused was got conducted at CHC Nuh. DNA were taken into police custody for record. In this case, arrest of accused Yashpal son of Kanwarpal is pending. It was further submitted that detailed investigation is being conducted and police is trying to arrest the remaining accused and on completion of the investigation, final report shall be submitted before learned Illaqua Magistrate.

So, keeping in view the above, no further order is required to be passed.

Present petition stands disposed of accordingly.
