1. The petitioner has filed the present petition under Section 528 of BNSS with a prayer to issue appropriate directions to the respondents No.1 to 3 to look into the matter and monitor the conduct of respondent No.4 in the present case. A further prayer has been made with a prayer to enquire the matter in a case arising out of FIR No.50, dated 04.06.2025, under Sections 115(2), 118(1),191(3),190 and 333 of B.N.S. Police Station Tarsikka, Amritsar Rural.

2. Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the petitioner has already submitted a representation dated 23.06.2025 (Annexure P-1) to the Director General of Police, Punjab -respondent No.2 and he shall be satisfied at this stage, if directions are issued to Senior Superintendent of Police, Police

District Amritsar Rural to look into the matter and take appropriate steps, in accordance with law.

3. In view of the prayer made by learned counsel for the petitioner and without expressing anything on the merits of the case, the present petition is allowed with a direction to the Senior Superintendent of Police, Police District Amritsar Rural, to look into representation dated 23.06.2025 (Annexure P-1) and take appropriate action within two weeks, in accordance with law.
