1. Prayer in the present petition filed under 528 of BNSS, 2023 seeking directions to official respondent Nos.1 and 2 to transfer the investigation of FIR bearing No.209 dated 12.07.2025 registered under Sections 105 and 3(5) of BNS, 2023 at Police Station Guruharsashai, District Bathinda (Annexure P-4) to any other independent agency outside District Bathinda.

2. Learned counsel for the petitioner *inter alia* contends that the petitioner has been falsely implicated in the FIR (*supra*) on the allegations that the petitioner and his family members mixed poisonous medicine in the alcohol of the deceased. Learned counsel further contends that the family of the deceased is falsely accusing the petitioner and demanding more money by making false complaints. Now, respondent No.5 and his family members are threatening the petitioner to cause harm to his family, by calling from an unknown number. He further submits that the petitioner has moved representation (Annexure P-3) but no action has been taken so far.

Learned counsel for the petitioner further submits that the petitioner would be satisfied in case a direction is issued to respondent No.2 to consider and decide the representation (Annexure P-3) submitted by the petitioner, in a time bound manner.

Mr. Subhash Godara, Addl. A.G. Punja, who is present in the Court, accepts notice on behalf of respondent Nos.1 to 4. Learned counsel for the petitioner is directed to supply a copy of complete paper book to learned State counsel today itself.

Keeping in view the prayer made by the petitioners and without commenting anything on the merits of the case, the present petition is disposed of with a direction to respondent No.2 to consider and decide the representation (Annexure P-3) submitted by the petitioner and take appropriate steps in view of the submissions made therein, within a period of four weeks from the date of receipt of certified copy of this order, in accordance with law.
