1. The petitioner has filed the present petition under Section 528 of BNSS, 2023, for issuance of directions to respondent nos.2 to 4 for deciding application dated 23.04.2025 (Annexure P-2) and for conducting proper and fair investigation in case FIR No.69 dated 12.12.2023, registered under Sections 420, 406, 120-B IPC and Section 13 of the Punjab Travel Professionals/Regulations Act, 2014, at Police Station Cheema, District Sangrur.

2. Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the petitioner is the complainant, who got the aforesaid FIR lodged on 12.12.2023 but the investigation in the aforesaid FIR is not making any headway due to undue pressure upon the police officers/officials and even the accused are not being arrested despite the fact that they have specifically been named in the FIR.

3. Notice to the official respondents only.

4. Mr. J.S. Arora,DAG, Punjab, accepts notice on behalf of the respondent-State and submits, on instructions, that the investigation is

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underway and undertakes that the same would be concluded within a period of four weeks from today.

5. Without entering upon an exercise to evaluate the evidentiary value of the documents placed on the file, I dispose of the petition with a direction to the official respondents to conclude the investigation in the aforesaid FIR within a period of four weeks from today, as undertaken by the learned State counsel, in accordance with law. However, the petitioner would be at liberty to approach this Court if any further cause of action arises.
