SUMEET GOEL, J. (Oral)

1. The prayer made in the petition reads thus:

“It is, therefore, respectfully prayed that the present petition may kindly be allowed and order dated 09.07.2025 (Annexure P-3) passed by Ld. Additional Sessions Judge, Kapurthala whereby respondent No. 2 has been granted Anticipatory Bail in FIR No. 207 dated 21.06.2025 (Annexure P-1) Under section 326 (a), 303 (2), 351 (2), 351 (3), 191 (3) and 190 BNS, 2023 P.S. Kotwali District Kapurthala may kindly be set aside and Anticipatory Bail granted to respondent No. 2 may kindly be cancelled, in the interest of justice.”
2. After arguing for some time, learned counsel seeks to withdraw the present petition so as to enable the petitioner to approach the concerned Sessions Court for cancellation of the anticipatory bail, as per law.
