RAJESH BHARDWAJ, J. (Oral)

1. Prayer in the present petition is for directing respondents No.2 & 3 not to harass the petitioners at the instance of respondents No.4 to 6, as the petitioners having married against the wishes of private respondents, with further prayer to protect the life and liberty of the petitioners as they apprehend grave and imminent threat to their lives at the hands of private respondents.

2. Learned counsel for the petitioners submits that both the petitioners are major and have married against the wishes of respondents No.4 to 6 and have sought protection to their life and liberty. They apprehend danger from respondents No.4 to 6. Their photographs and marriage certificate evidencing their marriage is on record as Annexures P-3 and P-4. Learned counsel for the petitioners states that petitioners have filed representation dated 21.07.2025 (Annexure P-5) before respondent No.2 i.e. Senior Superintendent of Police, Kapurthala.

3. Notice of motion to respondents No.1 to 3.

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4. On asking of the Court, Mr. J.S. Arora, D.A.G., Punjab, notice on behalf of the respondents-State.

5. Without entering upon an exercise to evaluate the evidentiary value of the documents placed on the file, I dispose of the petition with a direction to respondent No.2-Senior Superintendent of Police, Kapurthala, to decide the representation dated 21.07.2025 (Annexure P-5) of the petitioners and grant them protection, if any threat to their life and liberty is perceived. It is clarified that this order shall not be taken to grant immunity to the petitioners from legal action for violation of law, if any, committed by them. This order would not be understood having expressed any opinion whatsoever by this Court on the validity of the marriage of the petitioners.

6. Disposed of.
