1. Present petition has been filed seeking issuance of direction to respondents No.2 & 3 to protect the life and liberty of the petitioner and his old aged parents which is under eminent danger at the hands of respondents No.5 to 8 and further prayer has been made to decide the representation dated 19.07.2025 (Annexure P-2) filed by the petitioner.
2. Learned counsel for the petitioners submits that for the redressal of his grievance, petitioner has filed a representation dated 19.07.2025 (Annexure P-2) before respondent No.2 i.e. Commissioner of Police, Amritsar but the same has not been taken into consideration till date. He has further submitted that petitioner would be satisfied if representation dated 19.07.2025 (Annexure P-2) is decided in a time bound manner.
3. Notice of motion.
4. On the asking of the Court, Mr. J.S. Arora, D.A.G., Punjab, accepts notice on behalf of the respondents-State.

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5. After hearing counsel for the parties, respondent No.2-Commissioner of Police, Amritsar is directed to decide the representation dated 19.07.2025 (Annexure P-2) filed by the petitioner expeditiously preferably within one month from today, in accordance with law.

6. In view of the above, present petition is disposed of. However, the petitioner would be at liberty to pursue his remedy, if any further cause of action accrues.
