1. The present petition has been filed by the petitioner under Article 226 of the Constitution of India seeking issuance of directions to respondents No. 1 and 2 to protect the life and liberty of the petitioner as well as the property of Dera Takiya Baba Bharpur Shah from the hands of the private respondents.

2. After arguing for some time, learned counsel for the petitioner has submitted that the petitioner has submitted a representation dated 23.06.2025 to respondent No. 2-Commissioner of Police, Ludhiana raising his grievances as raised in the present petition but no action has been taken so far. It is further submitted that at this stage, the petitioner would be satisfied if appropriate direction is issued to respondent No. 2 to decide the aforesaid representation and take necessary action.

3. Notice of motion.

4. Mr. Eklavya Darshi, DAG, Punjab, who is present in Court, accepts notice on behalf of the respondent-State and submits that the needful shall be done in due course.

Keeping in view the limited prayer made by the petitioner, the present petition is disposed of with a direction to respondent No. 2- Commissioner of Police, Ludhiana to decide the aforesaid representation submitted by the petitioner within a period of one month from today by passing a speaking order in accordance with law and take necessary action, if so required. In the meantime, the official respondents are directed to protect the life and liberty of the petitioner.
