1. Seeking cancellation of bail granted to respondent No.2 vide order dated 27.08.2024 passed in CRM-M-33927-2024, petitioner has come up before this Court by filing the present petition under Section 483(3) of BNSS 2023 as respondent No.2 violated the undertaking given by her
2. Counsel appearing for respondent No.2 submits that he is handing over a demand draft of Rs.4 lacs to counsel for the petitioner, which is accepted by petitioner’s counsel. He further submits that demand draft of Rs.9 lacs was already given, therefore now out of a total of Rs.30 lacs in question, Rs.17 lacs are remaining, which she will pay by 31.12.2025.
3. At this stage, petitioner’s counsel submits that he is ready to withdraw the present petition and direction be issued to respondent No.2 to pay the remaining amount by

31.12.2025 and if he does not pay the amount by the time given, petitioner be given liberty to approach this court again for cancellation of bail.

4. Given above, petition is disposed of a withdrawn. Respondent No.2 is directed to pay the remaining amount to the petitioner by 31.12.2025 positively. Petitioner is at liberty to file application for cancellation of bail before this court if respondent No.2 fails to pay the remaining amount by the given time. Pending applications, if any, stand disposed of.
