1. The present petition has been filed by the petitioner under Article 226 of the Constitution of India, *inter alia*, praying for issuance of a writ in the nature of *mandamus* directing the respondent to regularize the services of the petitioner on the post of Clerk in terms of order dated 11.03.2016 (Annexure P-12) with all consequential benefits as per the Government of Haryana instructions dated 30.03.1973.

2. Learned counsel appearing on behalf of the petitioner, on instructions, submits that the petitioner shall be satisfied at this stage, if directions are issued to respondent No.2 to decide the legal notice dated 16.05.2025 (Annexure P-19), in a time bound manner.

3. Notice of motion.

4. Mr. Piyush Khanna, Additional Advocate General, Haryana, appears on behalf of respondents No. 1 & 2, on advance notice and waives service. He does not oppose the limited prayer made by the petitioner.

5. In view thereof, without commenting anything upon the merits of the claim raised by the petitioner, the instant petition is disposed of with a direction to respondent No. 2 to decide the legal notice dated 16.05.2025 (Annexure P-19) within a period of eight weeks from the date of receipt of certified copy of this order.

6. Respondent No.2/competent authority is also directed to provide opportunity of hearing to the petitioner and to pass a reasoned and speaking order while deciding the legal notice dated 16.05.2025 (Annexure P-19).

7. Disposed of in the aforesaid terms.
