1. The petitioner has filed the present petition under Section 528 of BNSS, 2023, for issuance of directions to respondent nos.2 and 3 for conducting fair and impartial investigation in FIR No.43 dated 08.04.2025, registered under Sections 126(2), 62, 351(2), 307 and 3(5) of the BNS, 2023 and Sections 25 and 27 of the Arms Act, 1959, at Police Station Cantt. Bathinda, District Bathinda.
2. Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the FIR in question was lodged way back but investigation is not being carried out in a free and fair manner and the same is not even making any headway as the accused persons have not been arrested till date.
3. Notice to the official respondents only.
4. Mr. J.S. Arora, DAG, Punjab, accepts notice on behalf of the respondent-State and submits that the investigation is underway and undertakes that the same would be concluded expeditiously.
5. Without entering upon an exercise to evaluate the evidentiary value of the documents placed on the file, I dispose of the present petition with

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a direction to the respondent-Investigating Agency to conclude the investigation in the aforesaid FIR expeditiously in a fair and impartial manner, preferably within a period of three months, in accordance with law. However, the petitioner would be at liberty to avail his remedy available to him under the law if any further cause of action arises.
