1. Ms. Priyanka Malik, Advocate has put in appearance on behalf of the respondents and has filed Power of Attorney, which is taken on record.
2. Learned counsel for the respondents has placed on record copy of the decision dated 30.01.2025 passed by the District Consumer Disputes Redressal Commission, Malerkotla, Punjab, to submit that the petitioner has filed a complaint under Section 35 of the Consumer Protection Act, 2019, claiming release of the electricity connection applied by his deceased-wife.
3. Learned counsel submits that this complaint was partly allowed by the Commission and respondents were directed to return the deposited amount of Rs.1445/- besides cost of Rs.7000/- besides interest, which has been paid. Learned counsel asserts that these material facts have been suppressed by the petitioner.
4. When confronted with the above facts, learned counsel for the



petitioner has sought and is granted permission to withdraw the petition.

5. Dismissed as withdrawn.
