1. The petition in hand has been preferred under Article 226 of the Constitution of India with the following substantive prayer(s):-

“It is respectfully prayed that present petition may kindly be allowed and necessary action may kindly be issued to respondents No.3 and 4 to protect the Life, Liberty and property of the petitioner, from the hands of the respondent No.5 to 10.

It is further prayed that necessary direction may kindly be issued to respondent No.3 and 4, to decide the applications dated 22.07.2025 (Annexure P-2 and Annexure P-3) filed by the petitioner for protection of life and liberty of the petitioner, from the hands of the respondent No.5 to 8.”

2. Learned counsel for the petitioner after arguing for sometime has limited his prayer by stating that he would be satisfied, for the *nonce*, if a direction is issued to Deputy Superintendent of Police, Budhlada, District Mansa to consider and take a conscious decision on the representation dated 22.07.2025 made by the petitioner (copy whereof has been annexed as Annexure P-2 with the petition in hand) in a time-bound manner.

3. Notice of motion.

4. On the strength of advance copy, Mr. Gurpartap S. Bhullar, AAG, Punjab accepts notice on behalf of respondent Nos.1 to 4. He has urged that he has no objection in case limited prayer made by the petitioner, for decision of his representation dated 22.07.2025 (Annexure P-2), is directed for.

5. Having heard learned counsel for the rival party(s) and upon perusal of the paper-book, this Court deems it appropriate to dispose of the petition in hand with the following directions:

- (i) Deputy Superintendent of Police, Budhlada, District Mansa is mandated to look into the representation dated 22.07.2025 (Annexure P-2) moved by the petitioner, objectively consider the grievance(s) raised therein & take ratiocinated decision thereupon within a period of 15 days from today. Said decision be conveyed to the petitioner within 7 days thereafter.
- (ii) No order as to costs.
