AMARJOT BHATTI, J.

1. Petitioner has filed instant petition under Section 528 of Bharatiya Nagarik Suraksha Sanhita, 2023 for issuing directions to respondent Nos.4 and 5 to arrest the accused persons/private respondents in FIR No.35 dated 05.03.2025 under Sections 3 (5), 351 (2), 64 (1) of Bharatiya Nyaya Sanhita, 2023 registered at Police Station Punhana, District Nuh (Annexure P-1) who is roaming freely in the village and giving threats to the petitioner and her family members regarding the aforesaid matter in controversy.

2. Status report has been called. As per status report, FIR (Annexure P-1) (*supra*) was registered and proper investigation is being carried out. Statement of victim was recorded under Sections 183 Bharatiya Nagarik Suraksha Sanhita, 2023 on 13.03.2025 (Annexure R-1).

Tower location of mobile numbers was collected. Report dated 28.05.2025 is Annexure R-2. Samim respondent No.6/accused has been arrested on 21.08.2025. Regarding other accused, investigating agency is making every possible effort to arrest them. It is assured that investigation is being conducted in a fair manner.

3. In view of the aforesaid status report, learned counsel for the petitioner has expressed his satisfaction. Therefore, no further direction is required. Regarding any threat perception to the petitioner, she may approach respondent Nos.4 and 5 who will consider the threat perception and will take appropriate steps accordingly.

4. Petition is, accordingly, disposed of.

5. Pending miscellaneous application(s), if any, stand disposed of accordingly as well.
