SUVIR SEHGAL, J. (ORAL)

1. This petition has been filed assailing order dated 07.08.2024, passed by the learned Civil Judge (Junior Division), Derabassi, whereby while issuing notice in the suit as well as in application under Order 39 Rules 1 and 2, CPC, trial Court has declined the prayer for grant of ad interim ex-parte injunction, at that stage.

2. Mr. Vishal Sodhi, counsel for the petitioner submits that the petitioner had to approach this Court as the defendants were not being served. He submits that in the meantime, after being served, defendants have put in appearance and proceedings before the trial Court are fixed for filing replication.

3. Be that as it may. As the application under Order 39 Rules 1 and 2 CPC is still pending adjudication, petition is disposed off with a



request to the Trial Court that after hearing the defendants, application be decided within a period of three months from the date of communication of copy of this order.

4. Interim order passed by this Court on 19.09.2024 shall remain in operation till then.
5. It is clarified that the said application shall be decided by the trial Court uninfluenced by the interim order passed by this Court.
