Main case:

1. Challenge in the present petition is to the order dated 14.05.2024 passed by respondent No.2 whereby the case of the petitioner for appointment to the post of Junior Coach (OSP) (Group-C) in view of the Haryana Outstanding Sports Persons (Grade A, B and C) Service Rules, 2021 has been rejected.

2. Learned counsel appearing on behalf of the petitioner(s) contends that the issue involved in the present case is covered by the ***judgment dated 29.07.2025*** passed by this Court in ***CWP-31692-2024*** titled as '***Surya Sangwan Vs. State of Haryana Through Director Sports & Youth Affairs and another***' and that the claim of the petitioner(s) be considered in light of the same.

3. Learned State counsel does not dispute the aforesaid factual position and has no objection for considering the claim of the petitioner(s) in accordance with law.

4. Accordingly, the present petition is ***disposed of*** with the consent of the parties and without commenting anything on the merits of the case with a direction to respondent(s)-authorities to consider the case of the petitioner(s) in accordance with law as well as in view of the ***judgment dated 29.07.2025*** passed by this Court in ***Surya Sangwan*** (supra).
