1. In the present writ petition filed under Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India, prayer is made for issuance of a writ in the nature of Mandamus for issuance of directions to the respondents to consider and decide the claim of the petitioner for regularization of his services as Motor Mate w.e.f. 01.02.1996 in the light of recommendations dated 24.08.2023 (Annexure P-1) and 26.03.2025 (Annexure P-3) respectively.

2. Learned counsel appearing for the petitioner, on instructions from the petitioner, submits that at this stage, the petitioner will be satisfied if a direction is given to respondent No.2 to decide his legal notice dated 09.06.2025 (Annexure P-4), in a time bound manner.

3. Notice of motion.

4. Mr. Piyush Khanna, Addl. AG, Haryana accepts notice on behalf of the respondents and he does not oppose the prayer, as made by the learned counsel for the petitioner.

5. In view of the above and without commenting upon the merits of the case, the present writ petition is hereby disposed of with a direction to respondent No.2 to decide legal notice dated 09.06.2025 (Annexure P-4), within a period of 08 weeks from the date of receipt of certified copy of this order.

6. Needless to say that the legal notice shall be decided in adherence with the principles of natural justice by giving due opportunity of hearing to the petitioner and by passing a detailed and reasoned speaking order.

7. Disposed of in the aforesaid terms.
