The instant petition has been filed seeking a writ of *mandamus* directing respondent no.2 to allow the petitioner to join her duties on the post of PRT teacher by granting extension of time, in terms of judgment, dated 13.09.2022, passed by the Supreme Court in SLP (C) Diary no.25269 of 2022 titled *Vikas Kumar and others v. The State of Haryana and others*.

2. Pursuant to the last order, learned State counsel has received instructions from the office of Chief Secretary to Government of Haryana, vide memo dated 17.11.2025, which is retained on the case file as Annexure 'A'. It reads as under:

2. I am further directed to inform you that the directions issued by the Hon'ble High Court vide order dated 04.11.2025 has been complied with on behalf of respondent no.1, vide U.O. No.01/09/2024-5HR-II dated 13.11.2025, and the Additional Chief Secretary to Government Haryana, School Education



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Department has been conveyed that relaxation in Government Instructions No. 42/43/84-5GS-1 dated 20.01.1988 and No. 42/06/2019-2GS-1 dated 25.06.2019 has been granted for issuing the appointment letter to the petitioner for the post of Primary Teacher against advertisement No.02/2012. It has also been conveyed that after issuing the appointment letter, the Administrative Department is competent authority to extend the joining time up to three months at its own level, as per Government Instructions bearing No.01/05/2019-1GS-1 dated 13.09.2019.

3. Learned State counsel further contends that after receiving clarification from the Chief Secretary, the petitioner was called for document verification on 17.11.2025, which has been completed. The case has now been submitted to the competent authority to issue directions to the concerned District Elementary Education Officer, who is the appointing authority of PRTs, and appointment letter will be issued to the petitioner within a period of two weeks. The instructions to that effect received from the second respondent, dated 17.11.2025, are also retained on the case file as Annexure 'B'.

4. In view of the statement made by learned State counsel, nothing survives for adjudication in the petition, and it stands disposed of.
