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**SURYA PARTAP SINGH, J. (Oral):**

1. This is a petition for anticipatory bail filed under Section 482 of Bharatiya Nagarik Suraksha Sanhita 2023, in a case arising out of FIR No.105 dated 21.06.2025, registered under Section 21 (b) of NDPS Act [Section 29 of NDPS Act added later on], Police Station Farakpur, District Yamuna Nagar.

2. Vide order dated 28.07.2025, the petitioner was admitted to interim anticipatory bail, subject to the condition of furnishing bail/surety bonds to the satisfaction of Arresting/Investigating Officer.

3. It has been submitted by learned counsel for the petitioner that in compliance with above mentioned order, dated 28.07.2025, the petitioner has already joined investigation.

4. On the instructions of ASI Irshad Ali, who is present in the Court, the learned State Counsel has submitted that in compliance with the order dated 28.07.2025, the petitioner has joined investigation, and that the custody of the petitioner is not required for further investigation of the present case.

5. In view of the above mentioned submission of learned State counsel, the order dated 28.07.2025, whereby interim anticipatory bail was accorded to the petitioner, is hereby made absolute.
6. Present petition stands allowed, accordingly.
