LISA GILL, J.

1. Prayer in this writ petition is for restraining the respondents from cancelling contract dated 09.04.2025 awarded to petitioner for collecting user charges. It is submitted that false, frivolous and vexatious complaints have been filed against petitioner without any basis. Moreover, respondents are not supplying the list of registered retail vendors at New Sabzi Mandi, Maqsudan, Jalandhar in terms of clause 21 of agreement dated 09.04.2025 (Annexure P1).

2. Learned counsel for State (on advance notice) points out that there are number of complaints against petitioner which are under consideration and orders dated 17.04.2025 and 16.07.2025 have been passed against petitioner. Appeals have been filed by petitioner challenging said orders and that no

cause of action has arisen to petitioner to approach this Court. Insofar as grievance of list of registered retail vendors not being provided is concerned, learned counsel for State refers to communication dated 04.08.2025 addressed by Secretary, Market Committee, Jalandhar city and submits that requisite list shall be provided to petitioner within three (03) days from today. It is, thus, prayed that this writ petition be dismissed.

3. Faced with same, learned counsel for petitioner seeks to withdraw this petition with liberty to pursue/avail remedy(ies) as may be available to it in accordance with law in case of any subsisting grievance.

4. Writ petition is, accordingly, dismissed as withdrawn with liberty as aforementioned.
