The jurisdiction of this Court has been invoked under Article 226/227 of the Constitution of India for directing the official respondents no. 2 & 3 to protect the life and liberty of the petitioners at the hands of respondent nos.4 to 9.

Learned State counsel submits that a speaking order dated 29.07.2025 has been passed on the representation submitted by the petitioners. A copy of the same has been supplied to the counsel for the petitioners. The relevant part of the order read as under:-

“Petitioner Sukhmandeep Kaur W/O Kulwinder singh R/O village Khudian Maha Singh D/O Vijay Singh r/o village Bazipuri Bhooma district Fazilka, registered a writ petition CRWP No. 8101/2025 in respected Punjab and Haryana High Court Chandhigarh, an intimation regarding the petition is received today in Police Station. Till now the above writ petitioner Sukhmandeep kaur etc does not

intimated or contacted and does not give her written statement in the local police station regarding safety of herself and her belongings. Writ Petition CRWP No. 8101/2025 regarding Sukhmandeep Kaur and others during investigation of village Khudiya Maha Singh AS Baljit Singh reached Khudiya Maha Singh and conducted investigation where petitioner Sukhmandeep Kaur and Kulwinder Singh were not found present at the house. If in future, petitioner Sukhmandeep Kaur etc has come to police station to demand safety of herself and her belongings, then safety will be provided according to Law. Petitioner has given her address as Sukhmandeep Kaur W/O Kulwinder singh R/O village Khudian Maha Singh D/O Vijay Singh r/o village Bazipuri Bhooma district Fazilka, in her writ petition.”

In the light of above, learned counsel for the petitioners prays for withdrawal of the present petition.

Prayer is accepted.

Dismissed as withdrawn.

However, the petitioners would be at liberty to avail alternate remedy by way of appeal as per notification No.HOME-HM-40 40SECM/14/2025-2H4/63 dated 23.01.2025 issued by the Department of Home Affairs, Punjab, Government of Punjab (Home-4 Branch).
