The petitioner seeks the grant of anticipatory bail under Section 482 of BNSS, 2023 in case bearing FIR No.324 dated 29.06.2025 under Section 306 BNS registered at Police Station Krishna Gate, Thanesar, Kurukshetra, Haryana.

The learned counsel for the petitioner submits that pursuant to the interim order dated 28.07.2025 passed by this Court, the petitioner has joined the investigation.

The learned counsel for the complainant, however, vehemently opposes the prayer for the grant of anticipatory bail on the ground that certain recoveries are yet to be effected.

The learned State counsel on instructions from ASI Surinder submits that the petitioner has joined the investigation in terms of the order dated 28.07.2025 and is not required for custodial interrogation.

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In view of the above, the interim order dated 28.07.2025 is made absolute.

However, the petitioner shall keep on joining the investigation as and when required to do so and he shall abide by the conditions as envisaged under Section 482(2) BNSS.

The petition stands disposed of.
