1. Learned counsel for the respondent has filed an affidavit of Sh. Harsuhinder Pal Singh Brar, IAS, State Project Director, Samagra Shiksha, Chandigarh, in compliance of the order dated 18.02.2025, which is taken on record.
2. Learned counsel for the respondent submits that the Dearness Allowance for the period from 01.03.2022 upto the date of resignation of the petitioners, along with interest, stands paid to the petitioners. This fact is not disputed by the learned counsel for the petitioners.
