1. In the present writ petition filed under Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India, prayer is made for issuance of a writ in the nature of *mandamus* directing the respondents to release the pensionary benefits alongwith other consequential benefits to the petitioners.

2. Learned counsel appearing for the petitioners, on instructions from the petitioners, submits that at this stage, the petitioners shall be satisfied if a direction is given to respondent No.3 to decide the representation dated 20.03.2025 (Annexure P-10), in a time bound manner.

3. Notice of motion.

4. Ms. Shruti, AAG, Punjab appearing for the respondent(s)-State does not oppose the prayer, as made by the learned counsel for the petitioners.

5. In view of the above and without commenting upon the merits of the case, the present writ petition is hereby disposed of with a direction to respondent No.3 to decide the representation dated 20.03.2025 (Annexure

P-10), if received by its office, within a period of 08 weeks from the date of receipt of certified copy of this order.

6. Needless to say that the representation shall be decided after giving due opportunity of hearing to the petitioners and by passing a detailed and reasoned speaking order.

7. Disposed of in the aforesaid terms.
