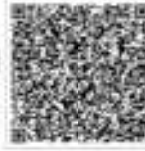

The petitioner has filed the present petition under Article 226 of the Constitution of India for issuance of a writ in the nature of certiorari for quashing the impugned order dated 30.06.2025 (Annexure P-15) passed by the Deputy Commissioner, Mansa-respondent No.4, whereby the claim of the petitioner for assigning him the duty of Senior Scale Stenographer in the office of Additional Deputy Commissioner (ADC), Mansa has been rejected and has been arbitrarily assigned the duty of A.S.D.A. in the office of SDM, Sardulgarh. A further prayer has been made that respondents may be directed to assign the duty of Senior Scale Stenographer to the petitioner in the office of A.D.C. (General) Mansa, where he was posted vide order dated 01.01.2025 against a sanctioned vacant post, after his promotion as Senior Scale Stenographer.

Learned State counsel, on instructions from Deputy Commissioner, Mansa, submits that at present the post of A.D.C.(General) , Mansa is lying vacant and additional charge has been given to Mr. Aakash Bansal, IAS. As such, the services of the petitioner in the said office are not required at this stage and he has been temporarily posted in the office of SDM, Sardulgarh. Learned State counsel further submits that as and when a new incumbent joins the post of ADC (General), Mansa regularly, the petitioner shall be attached with him immediately. Till then, the petitioner may be allowed to continue in the office of SDM, Sardulgarh.

Learned counsel for the petitioner has no objection to the statement made by the learned State counsel.

In view of the above, nothing survives in the present petition and the same is disposed of, accordingly.
