1. The petitioner has filed the present petition under Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India for issuance of directions to respondent no.2 for protection of life and liberty of the petitioner who is apprehending danger at the behest of respondent nos.5 to 8 and also to direct respondent no.2 to consider and take action on his representation dated 09.07.2025.

2. Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that on one hand the private respondents are not returning the money which they had usurped from the petitioner and his clients in the name of providing VISA and on the other hand, they are continuously harassing and extending threats to the petitioner. It is submitted that having no other option, the petitioner had filed representation dated 09.07.2025 (Annexure P-3) to respondent no.3 but no positive action has been taken so far by him.

3. Notice of motion to the official respondents only.

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4. Mr. J.S. Arora, DAG, Punjab, accepts notice on behalf of the respondent-State and prays for time to have instructions.
5. Without entering upon an exercise to evaluate the evidentiary value of the documents placed on the file, I dispose of the petition with a direction to respondent no.3- Commissioner of Police, Amritsar, District Amritsar to decide the representation (Annexure P-3) of the petitioner and grant protection to him, if any threat to his life and liberty is perceived.
6. It is clarified that this order shall not be taken to grant immunity to the petitioner from legal action for violation of law, if any, committed by him.
