The petitioner seeks grant of anticipatory bail under Section 482 read with Section 528 BNSS in case bearing FIR No.60 dated 28.05.2025 registered under Section 61 of the Punjab Excise Act, 1914 at Police Station Lohian, District Jalandhar Rural.

The learned counsel for the petitioner submits that in compliance of the order dated 01.08.2025, the petitioner has joined the investigation to the entire satisfaction of the Investigating Officer.

The learned State counsel on instructions admits the aforesaid fact and submits that the petitioner is no more required for further investigation in the case.

In view of aforesaid factual position, the interim order dated 01.08.2025 is made absolute. However, the petitioner shall keep on joining the investigation as and when required to do so and he shall abide by the conditions as envisaged under Section 482(2) BNSS.
