1. Present petition has been for directing respondents No.2 & 3 to protect the lives and liberty of the petitioners from the hands of respondents No.4 to 8 and not to interfere in the peaceful life of the petitioners at behest of respondent No.4 and other relatives by taking into consideration representation dated 26.07.2025 (Annexure P-3). Further prayer has been made for directing the official respondents to ensure the security of life and liberty of the petitioners, which is at the eminent danger at the hands of private respondents.

2. Learned counsel for the petitioners has submitted both the petitioners are major and living in live-in-relationship and have sought protection to their life and liberty. They apprehend danger from the private respondents. The petitioners have submitted a representation dated 26.07.2025 (Annexure P-3) to respondent No.2.

3. Notice of motion to respondents no.1 to 3-State only.

4. On the asking of the Court, Mr. Sumit Jain, Addl. A.G., Haryana accepts notice on behalf of the State.

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5. Without entering upon an exercise to evaluate the evidentiary value of the documents placed on the file, I dispose of the petition with a direction to respondent No.-2 i.e. Superintendent of Police, Nuh, to decide the representation dated 26.07.2025 (Annexure P-3) of the petitioners and grant them protection, if any threat to their life and liberty is perceived. It is clarified that this order shall not be taken to grant immunity to the petitioners from legal action for violation of law, if any, committed by them. This order would not be understood having expressed any opinion whatsoever by this Court on the validity of their live-in relationship.

6. Disposed of.
