1. The grievance of the petitioner is that she had instituted a complaint for the offence under Sections 420 and 120 B of IPC, in the Court of Judicial Magistrate Ist Class, SAS Nagar, Mohali and she has concluded her preliminary evidence, but thereafter, the complaint is being adjourned on the point of summoning as well as for awaiting the report under Section 202 Cr.P.C. A perusal of various orders placed on record also shows that matter is being adjourned only on account of non-receipt of report under Section 202 Cr.P.C. Despite report having been not received, no further action has been taken by the learned Magistrate against the SHO of concerned Police Station, as to why the report is being delayed and the complaint is being adjourned in routine.



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2. Accordingly, a direction is issued to the concerned Magistrate to call for the report under Section 202 Cr.P.C. from the concerned Police Station and if the matter is further delayed, Magistrate can take action against the SHO of the concerned Police Station under relevant provisions of Bharatiya Nagrik Suraksha Sanhita (BNSS). Thereafter, necessary order be passed without any further delay.

3. With the above direction, petition is disposed of.
