The petition has been filed *inter alia* seeking a writ of *mandamus* directing the respondents to consider the petitioner's claim on parity with the similar situated persons who have been allotted stations afresh vide orders dated 26.09.2024, Annexure P-5, and 24.04.2025, Annexure P-9, by the respondent-Parishad by reconsidering their representations.

2. Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that grievance raised herein is pending for appropriate decision before the respondents. At this stage, petitioner will be satisfied in case respondent no.2 is directed to

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decide her representation, dated 05.05.2025, Annexure P-7, in a specified period.

3. Notice of motion.
4. Ms. Tanushree Gupta, Senior Deputy Advocate General, Haryana, accepts notice on behalf of the respondent no.1 and 3/State. Mr. Sanjeev Kaushik, Advocate accepts notice on behalf of respondent no. 2-Parishad and submits that the pending representation, dated 05.05.2025, will be decided by respondent no.2/State Project Director, Haryana School Shiksha Pariyojna Parishad, by passing a speaking order in accordance with law within three months.
5. In view of the statement made, learned counsel for the petitioner has no objection to the petition being disposed of in terms thereof.
6. Ordered accordingly.
7. In case the order is not passed within the stipulated period, the officer concerned shall pay costs of ₹50,000 to the petitioner.
