2. The learned counsel for the private respondents admits that on account of improper information supplied, he had alleged that the petitioner No.1 was a minor, though, she is admittedly a major. He, further, states that the private respondents would not interfere in the marital life of the petitioners.

4. The learned counsel for respondents No.1 to 3-State has filed a reply dated 06.08.2025 which is taken on record. A perusal thereof would reveal that the petitioner No.1-Ramandeep Kaur is more than 18 years old. Further, the statements of the private respondents were recorded in which they have stated that they shall not interfere in the marital life of the petitioners.

5. In view of the above, no further orders are required to be passed by this Court.
