The jurisdiction of this Court has been invoked under Article 226/227 of the Constitution of India for directing the official respondents no. 2 & 3 to protect the life and liberty of the petitioners at the hands of respondent nos.4 to 9.

Learned State counsel submits that a speaking order dated 30.07.2025 has been passed on the representation submitted by the petitioners. A copy of the same has been supplied to the counsel for the petitioners. The relevant part of the order read as under:-

“The petitioner requested necessary protection for her life and liberty. During the enquiry, the above-mentioned individuals, Dinesh Kumar and his wife Lakshmi Devi, were contacted and their statements were recorded. They stated that they have no objection to the marriage of Nandi with Gurpreet Singh and have no intention of interfering in her personal life or causing her any harm. They further

stated that Nandi had been living peacefully and independently with her partner Gurpreet Singh. It is also pertinent to mention that, despite repeated efforts, the complainant Nandi could not be contacted, as she did not provide any mobile number or current address in her complaint. Therefore, her personal statement could not be recorded In light of the above facts and the statements of the alleged persons, no threat perception has been found at this stage, and no further action is warranted in this matter. Accordingly, this complaint is being filed in the record room. A copy of this speaking order is being placed on record. If the complainant is not satisfied with this speaking order, she may file an appeal after receiving this order. ”

In the light of above, learned counsel for the petitioners prays for withdrawal of the present petition.

Prayer is accepted.

However, the petitioners would be at liberty to avail alternate remedy by way of appeal as per notification No.HOME-HM-40 40SECM/14/2025-2H4/63 dated 23.01.2025 issued by the Department of Home Affairs, Punjab, Government of Punjab (Home-4 Branch).

Dismissed as withdrawn.
