SANJAY VASHISTH, J.

1. Present criminal writ petition has been filed under Articles 226 and 227 of the Constitution of India, seeking issuance of appropriate directions to respondents No. 2 and 3 to protect the life and liberty of the petitioners, and to restrain the private respondents No. 4 to 6, along with their family members, from harassing or interfering in the peaceful life of the petitioners.

2. On 29.07.2025, following order was passed:

“ It is noticed that except petitioner No.2, petitioner No.1 and private respondents No. 4 to 6 are residents of State of Himachal Pradesh.

Let the credentials of the petitioners be got verified from the concerned Police Stations.

List again on 12.08.2025.”

3. Today, learned State counsel, on instructions, submits that as per the statement of one Bhupinder Singh, son of Surjit Singh, resident of

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Lahori Gate, Patiala, it has been confirmed that even petitioner No. 2 is not residing at the given address. Thus, it appears that the petitioners have projected an address within the State of Punjab merely to obtain protective orders, although present petition is not maintainable before this Court. Accordingly, the petition appears to have been instituted without proper territorial jurisdiction.

4. At this stage, learned counsel for the petitioners submits that he may be granted an opportunity to file a fresh petition with better particulars, clearly setting out the reasons and facts to establish jurisdiction of this Court, along with supporting documents.

5. In view of the above, present petition is disposed of.

However, in light of the submission made by learned counsel for the petitioners, liberty is granted to the petitioners to file a fresh petition, in accordance with law.
