1. In the present writ petition filed under Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India, prayer is made for issuance of a writ in the nature of *mandamus* directing the respondents to promote the petitioner on the post of District Manager w.e.f. 05.12.2018 from the date when his juniors were promoted.

2. Learned counsel appearing for the petitioner, on instructions from the petitioner, submits that at this stage, the petitioner shall be satisfied if a direction is given to respondent No.2 to decide the representation dated 21.05.2024 (Annexure P-5), in a time bound manner.

3. Notice of motion.

4. Ms. Shruti, AAG, Punjab and Mr. Ranjit Singh Kalra, Advocate, accept notice on behalf of respondents No. 1 and 2, respectively and do not oppose the prayer, as made by the learned counsel for the petitioner.

5. In view of the above and without commenting upon the merits of the case, the present writ petition is hereby disposed of with a direction to respondent No.2 to decide the representation dated 21.05.2024 (Annexure P-5), if received by its office, within a period of 08 weeks from the date of receipt of certified copy of this order.

6. Needless to say that the representation shall be decided after giving due opportunity of hearing to the petitioner and by passing a detailed and reasoned speaking order.

7. Disposed of in the aforesaid terms.
