1. Prayer in the instant civil writ petition filed under Articles 226/227 of Constitution of India is for issuance of a writ in the nature of certiorari for quashing the order dated 25.09.2015 (Annexure P-5); order dated 08.10.2015 (Annexure P-6) and also order dated 01.11.2022 (Annexure P-14), passed by Deputy Commissioner, SBS Nagar, whereby the representation submitted by the petitioner for restoring the land comprised in Khasra No. 57//4/2 (7-11) and 5/2 (7-11), total land measuring 15 Kanal – 2 Marla, situated at village Khoja, Tehsil Nawanshahr, District SBS Nagar, has been rejected.

2. Learned State counsel, on instructions from Mr. Jasbir Singh, Personal Assistant to Deputy Commissioner, SBS Nagar (Nawanshahr), has informed the Court that initially 79 Kanal – 19 Marla area was sold to one Tarsem Singh in an open auction and thereafter, the petitioner had purchased 15 Kanal – 2 Marla area from Tarsem Singh. It is stated that the mutation in respect of land, which was sold to Tarsem Singh, was cancelled by the Government, however, as on date, the land stands restored to Tarsem Singh. Accordingly, learned State counsel submits that the petitioner shall have to approach the concerned Revenue Officer for seeking correction of revenue entries and/or mutation entries based upon her title documents, in accordance with law.

3. At this stage, learned counsel for petitioner submits that in view of stand taken by learned State counsel, he may be permitted to withdraw this writ petition with liberty to the petitioner to apply afresh for correction of revenue entries and/or for sanctioning of mutation in favour of the petitioner on the basis of her title documents i.e. sale deed dated 15.04.2015, executed by Tarsem Singh, in her favour.

4. Ordered accordingly.

5. Pending application (s), if any, shall also stand closed.
