Prayer in the present writ petition, filed under Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India, is for issuance of a writ in the nature of Mandamus for directing respondent No.2 to correct the place of birth of the petitioner in his passport.

2. At this stage, Mr. Prajwal Chauhan, Central Government Counsel, appears on behalf of respondents-IOI through video conferencing mode, in pursuance of the advance copy of paper book having already been supplied to Union of India and submits that although the petitioner had sought an appointment with the Regional Passport Office, Jalandhar-2,

however, he has not submitted any application for correction of the place of birth of the petitioner in his passport. It is further submitted that in case the petitioner submits a duly filled up application along with the supported documents, the said application of the petitioner would be considered and final decision shall be taken thereon in accordance with law, within a period of eight weeks from the date when such application is submitted by the petitioner.

3. Keeping in view the aforesaid submissions made by learned counsel for the respondents/UOI, the present writ petition is accordingly disposed of.

4. All pending application(s), if any, shall also stand closed.
