The petition has been filed seeking a writ of *mandamus* directing the respondents to step-up the petitioner's pay at par with that of his junior, Shivender Sharma, and revised his pensionary benefits accordingly.

2. Learned State counsel has received instructions from the second respondent/Director, Secretary Education, vide memo dated 21.08.2025, which is retained on the case file as Annexure 'A'. Referring to the same, she contends that the Department is examining the petitioner's case for stepping-up of pay as his service book as well as that of his junior has been received from the concerned District Education Officer.

3. In view thereof, the petition is disposed of directing the second respondent to finally decide the petitioner's case for stepping-up of pay and release all consequential benefits as admissible, within a period of three months.



4. In case the order is not passed within the stipulated period, the officer concerned shall pay costs of ₹50,000 to the petitioner.
