1. Challenge in the present writ petition is to the order dated 06.09.2022 passed in Complaint No. 3929 of 2022 passed by the Punjab State Commission for NRIs alleging that the same was illegal, arbitrary and without jurisdiction.

2. Vide the above said order, the Commission had observed that in view of the facts and circumstances of the matter, the same required a thorough and independent probe. The matter was referred to the Director General of Police, Punjab to ensure that the matter is probe through an independent agency.

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3. Counsel for the respondent-State as well as the respondent No.3 informs that the Investigating Officer has already filed a cancellation report in the matter and as such the grievance does not survive any further.

4. In view of the aforesaid statement, the question which survives is only the academic.

5. Keeping the said question open, the present petition is disposed of as having rendered infructuous at this stage in view of the subsequent developments. Liberty is, however, granted to the petitioner to seek revival of the present writ petition, in case the grievance of the petitioner still subsists.

6. All the pending miscellaneous application(s), if any, are also disposed of.
