SUVIR SEHGAL, J.(ORAL)

1. Petitioner has approached this Court under Article 226/227 of the Constitution of India, *inter alia*, for issuance of a writ in the nature of mandamus, seeking direction to respondents to remove the electricity pole from the land of the petitioner.

2. The petitioner has an alternate remedy available to him under the law. This Court is not inclined to exercise its discretionary extraordinary powers under Article 226 of the Constitution of India to direct the respondents to remove the electricity pole installed on the land of the petitioner.
