The present civil writ petition has been filed under Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India for issuance of a writ in the nature of *certiorari* for setting aside the impugned order bearing No. SHGB dated 24.09.2024 (Annexure P-7) passed by respondent No.4 and further for issuance of a writ in the nature of *mandamus* directing the respondents to provide compassionate appointment to the petitioner against the suitable post in consideration of his eligibility as per the policy of the Sarva Haryana Gramin Bank applicable at the time of death of his father.

2. Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the appointment letter has been issued in favour of the petitioner, as such, nothing survives in the present petition and the same has become infructuous.

3. In view of the above, the present petition is disposed of as having been rendered infructuous.
