1. Prayer in the present petition is for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioner in case FIR No.0062 dated 20.04.2025, registered under Sections 103, 61 (2) of BNS and Sections 25, 27, 30, 54 & 59 of the Arms Act, at Police Station City Malout, District Sri Muktsar Sahib.
2. Vide order dated 14.11.2025, while granting interim protection, the petitioner was directed to join investigation.
3. Learned Senior counsel for the petitioner has submitted that pursuant to order dated 14.11.2025, petitioner has joined the investigation and as such his interim bail may be made absolute.

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4. Learned Senior counsel appearing on behalf of the complainant has opposed the submissions made on behalf of the petitioner.

5. Learned State counsel, on instructions from HC Sandeep, has affirmed the fact that the petitioner has joined the investigation and he is no more required for further investigation.

6. In view of the above, interim order dated 14.11.2025 is made absolute subject to compliance of conditions as envisaged under Section 482 (2) B.N.S.S.

7. Petition stands allowed.
