SUDEEPTI SHARMA J. (Oral)

1. The present contempt petition has been filed for deliberate and intentional disobedience of order dated 11.01.2024 passed by this Court in CWP-569-2024.

2. The above said writ petition was disposed of in terms of the decision dated 16.12.2023 rendered in CWP No. 14591-2023 and other connected case. The operative part of order dated 16.12.2023 passed by this Court in CWP No. 14591-2023 and other connected case is reproduced as under:-

“13. At this stage, learned counsel submits that the petitioners intend to approach the Civil Court to raise the claim for compensation for their wrongful denial of appointment at the initial stage. For this, no liberty is needed. In case the petitioners feel aggrieved against any action of the respondents they are within their rights to agitate their claim in case the same will be admissible to them under law.”

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3. In compliance of the order dated 11.01.2024, affidavit dated 12.08.2025 of Mr. Vivek Padam Singh, Controller, Printing and Stationery Department, Haryana, Panchkula has been filed. The relevant portion of the same reads as under:-

“That in pursuance of the directions of this Hon'ble High Court dated 11-01-2024 and instructions of the Chief Secretary to Govt. of Haryana vide its Memo No. 42/79/2023-5HR-II dated 05-07-2024, the respondent has passed the speaking order bearing Memo No. P&SH-2024/1268/Admn dated 15-7-2024 whereby the claim of the petitioner has accepted and he was given the service benefits (on Notional basis) with retrospective effect and entitled for the appointment/seniority (on notional basis) from the date when the candidates lower in merit were granted the appointment. The copy of the order No. P&SH-2024/1268/Admn dated 15-07-2024 is annexed as Annexure R-1.”

4. In view of the above, order dated 11.01.2024 passed by this Court in CWP-569-2024 has already been complied with. This fact is not disputed by learned counsel for the petitioner.

5. Accordingly, the contempt is purged. Rule is *discharged*.

6. Pending application (s) if any also stands disposed of.
