1. Learned counsel for the parties submits that the issue has been amicably decided between the parties and the petitioner will be given the maintenance as fixed by the Tribunal vide order dated 28.09.2022 i.e. both the sons will pay Rs.5000/- each per month to the petitioner to be paid by the 10th of every month, which order has been upheld by the appellate authority.
2. Learned counsel appearing on behalf of the respondents submits that they agree to comply with the said directions and they will not

only take care of their mother and father but also pay the financial maintenance in compliance of order dated 28.09.2022 and any arrears admissible in lieu of the said order will also be deposited in the account of the parents within a period of two months from today and the amount of maintenance will be deposited by the 10th of every month as directed.

3. Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the present petition may kindly be disposed of as having been not pressed any further with liberty to avail appropriate remedy in case, there is a default on the part of the children qua the payment of financial monthly maintenance as undertaken by them.

4. Ordered accordingly.

5. Pending application, if any, also stands disposed of.
