JAGMOHAN BANSAL, J. (ORAL)

1. The petitioners through instant petition under Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India are seeking direction to respondent to restrain them from terminating their services.

2. The petitioners are working under National Health Mission (NHM) undertaken by Government of India. They are apprehending that their services may be terminated.

3. Learned counsel representing respondents No.2 to 4 submits that petitioners are continuing due to interim orders of this Court. The services of the petitioners would not be discontinued till the National Health Mission is in force and approval of their posts is duly received. At present they have approval till 2026. They would not be substituted by

another set of employees.

4. Faced with this, learned counsel representing the petitioners does not press the petition.

5. In the wake of statements of both sides, the petition stands *disposed of*.

6. The petitioners would be at liberty to avail remedies as permissible by law if their services are terminated contrary to aforesaid statement.
