The prayer in the petition under Section 482 Bharatiya Nagarik Suraksha Sanhita (BNSS), 2023 is for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioner in case FIR No.100 dated 08.07.2025 registered under Sections 420, 465, 468, 471, 34 IPC, 1860 (now sections 318(4), 336(2), 336(3), 340(2), 3(5) of the Bharatiya Nyaya Sanhita, 2023) registered at P.S. Qadian, Police District Btala, District Gurdaspur.

Learned Counsel for the petitioners submits that pursuant to the interim order dated 01.08.2025 **passed** by this Court, petitioner have joined the investigation.

The learned State Counsel on instructions submits that the petitioner have joined investigation in terms of orders dated 01.08.2025 and are not required for custodial interrogation.



In this view of the matter, interim order dated 01.08.2025 is made absolute.

However, the petitioners shall keep on joining the investigation as and when required to do so and they shall abide by the conditions as envisaged under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.
